This serves to advise stakeholders of the following PDE dates for the financial year 2025/2026. All property practitioners who still need to complete PDE are advised that PDE registrations are strictly completed online via MyPPRA Portal.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS/ DATES/PERIODS:	<p>Professional Designation Examination ('PDE') registration or enrolment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PDE registration/enrolment is done strictly via MyPPRA Portal. • No registration /enrolment forms (including those used in the past and are in possession of exam candidates or in the PPRA archived documents) will be issued or accepted for the purposes of registration or enrolment for ALL examinations scheduled by the PPRA. Exam registration or enrolment is strictly completed via MyPPRA Portal. • The venue that is on the MyPPRA Portal is merely used for exam registration or enrolment purposes and does not suggest that the exam will be venue-based or conducted orally. All exams are strictly taking a take-home exam approach unless otherwise communicated by the PPRA. Instructions for take- 	

home exam are communicated when PPRA opens each exam for registration or enrolment on MyPPRA Portal.

- Payment for PDE registration /enrolment must be made using the correct 7-digit individual reference number and made and paid for by the closing date. No exceptions will be allowed.
- Exam candidates need not email payment proofs to PPRA as exam fees paid using the correct 7-digit individual reference number will reflect on the PPRA Bank statements.
- Exam Seat Number will be allocated to exam candidates who registered and paid using the correct reference number. The seat number serves the purpose of uploading results and it will be reflected or be viewable by successfully registered exam candidates when they logon on MyPPRA Portal.

Postponements:

- All exam postponement requests must be made in writing and accompanied with supporting reasons and documents.
- Such must be submitted at least 14 days before the exam date, or the candidate will forfeit payment made. Those with unforeseen circumstances which are supported and submitted after the set timelines will be assessed and approved on merit.
- The PPRA reserves the right not to accept postponement requests.

Appeals:

- Appeals against communicated PDE results must be lodged by writing to resultsappeal@theppra.org.za, with a Notice of Appeal against PDE results, indicating who is the appellant (ID number, 7 digit reference and name and surname), also specifying which PDE results are being appealed and accompanied with a payment proof of the required fee (as per PPRA schedule of fees) by no later than 10 - 14 days from the date of publishing or communicating of exam results concerned. No late appeals or requests after these prescribed timelines will be accepted.
